

"Spider" Ceiling Lamp Joe Colombo 1960 Enameled metal and chrome stem. Adjustable shade. Designed by Joe Colombo in 1963. Manufactured by OLuce.

The Spider lamp won in 1967 the Compasso d'Oro. Spider was developed as a single lighting fixture that could host a special horizontal spot-light bulb. Its melamine joint meant it could be mounted on different supports (table/floor/wall/ceiling), thereby developing the concept of a lamp family.
