Einar Nerman (1888-1983) was a Swedish illustrator and artist. He studied at the "Konstnärsförbundet" in Stockholm and later at the Académie Colarossi in Paris. Nerman studied together with Henri Matisse from 1909-1910. In the 1920s, Nerman lived in London and worked for the magazine The Tatler, gaining fame for his outstanding caricatures.
